EDUSAVE CHARACTER AWARD (ECHA)

The Ministry of Education introduced Edusave Character Award (ECHA) in 2012 to recognise students who demonstrate exemplary character and outstanding personal qualities through their behaviour and actions. This is part of the larger goal to foster an inclusive and stronger Singapore, as we broaden qualities and achievements to be encouraged and applauded.

The eligibility criteria of the award are as follows:

1. The nominee is a Singapore citizen.
2. The nominee must, on a consistent basis, demonstrated good character and values. In particular, the nominee has demonstrated the following types of qualities
 - (i) School values of AI RISE (**R**esilience, **I**ntegrity, **S**teadfastness and **E**xcellence) with **C**are, **C**ourage and **G**ratITUDE; and/or
 - (ii) A high level of civic responsibility where the nominee showed concerned about issues in the community or issues faced by others, initiating action to address these issues to improve the lives of others, and being committed to make a positive difference; and/or
 - (iii) Qualities associated with outstanding character where nominee has demonstrated exemplary character, and who can be role models to inspire others.
